# Building Your Network.

Map the people you need across the organization and build working relationships with them. Participants leave with a network map and the influencing techniques to use it.

For

Anyone who wants to be more visible in their organization, open doors to opportunities, and work more effectively with others.

Format

One day. In person or live virtual.

## What it is for.

In most organizations, things get done through relationships across functions. People who build those relationships get their priorities addressed. People who do not are overlooked, and working from home makes that easier.

Participants first map their potential network inside the organization: the functions they need to reach and the people worth knowing. They then practice influencing techniques and strategies for building support for their ideas, gaining stakeholder buy-in, and getting the cooperation their priorities depend on.

- Insight into your own ability to build and keep working relationships
- Influencing techniques for building support and stakeholder buy-in
- An action plan for strengthening your network
